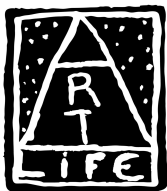
Your field trip schedule will be confirmed in 48 hrs.

# Film Fest Field Trip Registration:

## MAIN THEATER FILM PRESENTATION

- 60 Mins - Industry guest will welcome students and discuss the art of filmmaking followed by a curated series of Short Film Screenings and a lively Q & A session - Students will experience a festival setting and see films in a large group. Opportunity to meet visiting filmmakers & directors.

## SELECTED EXHIBITS & ACTIVITIES

- 20 Mins - Experimental Film Workshop - Students will work with guest filmmaker to participate in an experimental *hands-on art & film* project. Each student may participate in making individual sections of the film and the finished film is posted online.
- 10-15 Mins - World Arts Film Circles - Students break into small groups for roundtable discussions with experts from the creative industries. Q&A with filmmakers, animators, actors, screenwriters, producers, cinematographers.
- 20 Mins - Making Meaning through Films - An interactive theater games workshop explores how young audiences make meanings through their experience of films. Participants will communicate with one another about their film experiences within a theatre activity.
- 20 Mins - Visual Effects Production Workshop - Students will participate in a Special Effects Demo in a “green screen” studio, and then move inside the production control room to see how it’s done!
- 5-10 Mins - World Arts Film Festival “*Connecting Cultures*” Exhibit is introduced by a guest visual artist. Students will learn about this unique collection of visual art which includes the Festival’s Official Kaleidoscope Award. The award is the original and actual kaleidoscope artwork created for the festival by Japanese artist Koji Yamami.
- 5-10 Mins - Fun Photo Opportunities on the Red Carpet! Lights! Cameras! Action! The Festival’s Red Carpet area is a great place to take photos and selfies at the World Arts Film Festival School Field Trip! Meet the Celebs!
